Dear Residents and Interested Parties,

We have three quick noteworthy items:

- Residents **no longer have to limit water usage due to the sewer spill** at the stormwater inlet behind Bethel Creek. It has been temporarily repaired until after Thanksgiving. They are unsure exactly how large the spill was, as the City reported the old cast iron pipe could have been spilling 100,000 gallons a day from Sunday through Friday through a 2" hole in a 12" pipe that also had a 4' long crack.
- You are invited to help support the **Special Olympics** by joining us at a **pancake breakfast hosted by the Indian River Shores Public Safety Department on Saturday, December 2nd from 8-10 a.m.** The \$5 donation covers pancakes, eggs, sausage, bacon, coffee and juice.
