## 2015 Year in Review

- 
- Financial:**
- 2014/2015 budget had a 4.7% surplus
  - 2015/2016 budget had no increase in millage rate
  - State TRIM process had no infractions
  - Final 3 year extension with Treasure Coast Refuse negotiated (minimal increases)
- 
- Staff:**
- Hired new Public Safety Director Rich Rosell
  - Elections held March 2015 (3 candidates for 2 seats)
  - Hired a part-time Town Manager/Town Clerk Administrative Assistant
  - Performed In-depth Study of PSD Staffing
- 
- General:**
- Town website ( <http://www.irshores.com> ) underwent extensive renovation
  - Small Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment approved for lot at A1A and Beachcomber Lane rezoning from Residential to C1A
  - Building Department ISO Assessment completed – excellent rating obtained
  - Town-wide ISO Assessment completed – awaiting results
  - Year 2 NPDES Stormwater Drainage report to FDEP
  - \$1,000 JAG Grant obtained for Public Safety (Law Enforcement Related)
  - Entered into the Town/County Inter-Local Fertilizer Enforcement Agreement

### Capital or Infrastructure Improvements:

- Indian Lane \$72,500 Nutrient Separating Baffle Box grant completed *under* budget
  - Pebble Bay curb replacements installed
  - Two new paver parking spaces at Town Cemetery Completed
  - Obtained FDOT approval for tie-in to their drainage system on Fred Tuerk Drive
  - New carpeting in the Community Center
  - Installed 2 new ADA compliant water fountains at Town Hall (replacing one)
