### **Vero Beach Issues Boil-Water Alert After Power Failure at Treatment Plant**

We just learned that all City water customers are on a boil-water alert after the water treatment plant briefly lost power this morning.

City officials called the move - which is intended to kill bacteria in the water - "precautionary." It could last up to three days, they said, until testing shows the water is safe to drink.

Power to the plant has been restored, but the water pressure dropped below acceptable levels. Officials said customers should boil all water used for drinking or cooking. A rolling boil of one minute is considered sufficient, officials said in a news release.
