VERO BEACH — The **boil-water advisory** for all Vero Beach water customers **has been lifted**, city officials said Wednesday.

"It's all clear," said Water and Sewer Department Director Robert Bolton.

Two consecutive days of water samples showed **no contamination** in the city's water, Bolton said.

Customers were placed on a precautionary boil-water advisory on Monday after the city water-treatment plant briefly lost power. The problem occurred when a 20-year-old switch at the plant failed, shutting down a backup electrical generator being used at the time.
