

ORDINANCE NO. 502

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN RIVER SHORES RELATING TO LANDSCAPE OF FENCES; AMENDING SECTION 150.035(5) CHAIN LINK FENCING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN RIVER SHORES, FLORIDA, HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: Section 150.035, Residential districts, (5) *Chain link fencing*, is amended to read as follows:

"(5) *Chain-link Fencing*. ~~Chain-link~~ Fencing shall be ~~totally~~ planted with landscape material not less than 18 inches in height so that the fence shall be covered in a reasonable period of time. This restriction of height and landscaping does not apply to tennis, temporary construction or agricultural fencing. ~~Chain-link~~ Fences abutting a street or adjacent residence or residential lot shall have the required landscape material planted on the street side or adjacent residence or residential lot side of the fence as appropriate."

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Indian River Shores, Florida.


