

Indian River Shores Town Attorney

The Charter of the Town of Indian River Shores states in Article 3-1 that “the town council will appoint a town attorney who shall serve at the pleasure of the town council. The person appointed to fill the office of town attorney shall be an attorney at law in good standing, licensed to practice in the State of Florida but not necessarily a resident within the corporate limits of the Town of Indian River Shores.” His duties are described as to “represent the town, its agencies, boards, commissions authorities, officers and employees in all matters relating to their official duties as directed by the town council.”
