

Conditional Accessory Uses

Town of Indian River Shores Land Development Code

Sec. 160.02. -

(F)Accessory uses. Accessory buildings or uses customarily incidental to any of the permitted uses, including, but not limited to, the below. The location of more than one accessory use other than a swimming pool on the same property shall be considered a conditional accessory use subject to the criteria and procedures in (G) below.

- (G) Conditional accessory uses.
- (1) Conditional accessory uses are subject to submittal and approval by the Building Official upon receipt and consideration of the following:
 - (a) Letter of no objection from adjoining property owners;
 - (b) Letter of no objection from any property owner's association (if applicable);
 - (c) Survey and other site information to show the location of all structures on the site; and
 - (d) Such other information as the Town Building Official may request.
- (2) Review considerations. In considering the request for more than one accessory use other than a swimming pool, the Building Official may consider:
 - (a) The size of the lot, its characteristics and location;
 - (b) Proposed location and screening of the use;
 - (c) Lot coverage and green area remaining; or
 - (d) Other factors that may be brought to the attention of the Building Official.
